**Agroecology** is the application of ecological concepts to the design and management of sustainable food systems. In this course contemporary **food system issues** related to **food security** and **environmental impact** will be examined from an agroecological perspective.

This course includes a weekly field lab at the Cal Poly Student Experimental Farm where students will manage a quarter-long cropping experiment.

**This course is open to students of all majors but space is limited.** The only requirement is junior standing and an interest in the ecology of agriculture.

The course also serves as an alternative for ENVM students to fulfill their NR 306: Natural Resource Ecology requirement.
