- By 1950, Haiti was the third largest coffee exporter in the world
- The impact of the U.S embargo in Haiti during the 1990's resulted in deforestation of Coffee trees and by the beginning of the 21st century, there was an excess of coffee beans worldwide, thus reducing prices of coffee exports.
- The Haitian Bleu coffee bean has initiated a revival to Haitian coffee, bringing awareness back to the Haitian Coffee.
