I like that you have a mission and goals. I *think* what you're doing is great, but I'm not sure because I got confused by your presentation. I may just have been fatigued and I take responsibility for that. However, there's something that I think you could do to help things for viewers. You have a lot of text in your slides and it's not the same as what you are saying so the audience is left to choose if I want to read the text or listen to the discussion and for me it's disorientating. What I recommend is replace each sentence with a single word that can help you remember what you want to say.... Maybe two or three words. It will also give the audience something to focus on while you talk.

I really liked the statement of a Mission and Goals. I think it would be great if every group identified a mission (of what needs to be done) and a vision (of what they want to create or become).
