## **Abstract:**

People in rural Africa earn incomes that are 100 times lower than ours in the US, yet, they pay a price per unit electricity that is 100 times higher than us. The result is that they have access to about 10,000 times less electricity than we do. In this talk, I describe a strategy for getting the cheapest solar electricity to some of the lowest income people in the world. This strategy--if successful--may allow African villagers to be more productive and happy through increased electricity use and decreased use of polluting energy sources and manual labor.
